We were contacted with a requirement to source and supply body-worn cameras for over 470 security officers to operate on 100 major construction sites, ultimately to record security incidents as a part of their total security provision service.

It features nationwide Push-to-talk (PTT) communication over public and PMR networks, best-in-class audio performance, high-definition (HD) video shooting, and ergonomic design. With its slim profile (measuring 20 mm thickness and weighing just 172g) the VM580D fits easily in your hand or on uniform. Capturing 1080p HD video at 30 fps, a clear image is available in all conditions - the video content quality is always smooth, sharp, and stable, and all the important details will never be missed. It is the most effective product on the market for our client.
